

Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen's meeting August 15, 2016

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis, and Jim Rousmaniere; Don Tardiff, Gus Lerandean, Road Agent Ken Buffum

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of August 8 were approved.

Gus Lerandean, representing Alstate, the prime contractor for the city of Keene paving work on Roxbury Road, requested permission to extend the paving from the bridge over Otter Brook to the intersection at the Four Corners, the effect being to continue the paving job past the city/town line to a short section of the road in Roxbury. The selectmen granted such permission.

The selectmen responded to two inquiries from members of the public, one being a property owner who had questions related to the sale of land on which a communications tower is standing and the other being an out-of-towner who sought tax-related information about a piece of property he is considering acquiring.

Selectman Davis prepared the manifest of bills to be paid; the manifest was signed by the selectmen.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
