

Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen's meeting August 29, 2016

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis, Tim O'Brien and Jim Rousmaniere; Road Agent Ken Buffum; DRA representatives Josephine Belville and Vicky Ayer; Kyle Martin and Jon Miner of the Ridge Skippers Snowmobile Club

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of August 22 were approved.

Road Agent Buffum discussed his plans for road maintenance and repairs through the end of 2016.

The selectmen were visited by two representatives of the of the Municipal and Property Division of the NH Department of Revenue Administration on a courtesy call: Josephine Belville and Vicky Ayer, who is new to the Roxbury file. A general discussion took place.

The selectmen were visited by two members of the Ridge Skippers Snowmobile Club who had been approached by the Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests regarding the use of roads in the Taves reservation, which the Society owns and oversees. The selectmen discussed prior communications that they have had with the Society regarding the property.

Selectman O'Brien reported on time-consuming complications and frustrations involving the ability of the town clerk's computer to successfully print auto registrations. He reported that work on the matter is continuing.

Selectman Rousmaniere reported that he had alerted the state Department of Transportation to a correction that ought to be made on the designation of roads in town, specifically the fact that the Willard Road should properly be designated as a class VI road.

Selectman Davis prepared the manifest of bills to be paid; the manifest was signed by the selectmen.

The meeting adjourned at 9 p.m.
