

Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen's meeting August 8, 2016

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis, Tim O'Brien and Jim Rousmaniere; Chip Drogue; Fred Baybutt; Treasurer David Jewett

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of August 1 were approved.

Chip Drogue submitted the final bill for the Town Hall kitchen upgrade. He reported that the total cost came in \$1,200 under budget.

The selectmen took receipt of an inquiry from the state government seeking information about flood control reimbursements. Responsive material was prepared for submission.

The selectmen approved and signed a final draft of a letter to the Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests regarding a request that it had made to formally treat a road on its property as a private road. The selectmen's research on the matter produced documentation that the road is a public road, and so the letter said.

There was discussion regarding a property owner's question regarding zoning regulations and road frontage. The zoning laws do not differentiate between Class V roads and Class VI roads. The selectmen determined that RSA 674:41 ("Local Land Use Planning") adequately addresses the matter. The property owner in question will be so notified.

Fred Baybutt of Granite Gorge presented a permit application, including the appropriate fee, for an "Old Guy Music Fest" on August 27. The selectmen approved the permit request. Baybutt also filed applications (but without the \$100 permit) for a hill climb on Sept. 10 and another hill climb on Oct. 8. On a related matter, and with the assistance of town treasurer Jewett, the selectmen ascertained that a bill for police services to Granite Gorge last spring had in fact been paid.

The meeting adjourned at 9:10 p.m.
