

Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen's meeting Dec. 19, 2016

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis, Tim O'Brien and Jim Rousmaniere

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of Dec. 12 were approved.

At the request of the Society for the Protection of New Hampshire Forests, a meeting with representatives of that group and also the Ridge Skippers Snowmobile Club regarding the Taves reservation was scheduled for December 27 at Town Hall.

The selectmen discussed with a solar installer representative proposed solar panel installations at two private properties in town. It was agreed that at some point in the future the selectmen will revise its permit policy to smooth the process of permit application.

The selectmen voted unanimously to draw already-approved dollars in the building capital reserve fund to have the main floor of town hall sanded before Dec. 31; the job, to be handed by Clem's Floor Sanding, will also include the stairs.

The selectmen approved and signed a document prepared by Avitar, the town's property appraiser, that established the town's assessment to sales ratio at 109%.

The selectmen approved a special event permit submitted by Granite Gorge for a snowmobile hill climb on January 1.

Selectman Davis prepared the manifest of bills to be paid; the manifest was signed by the selectmen.

The meeting adjourned at 8 p.m. to enable the selectmen to attend a holiday celebration for town employees on the main floor of Town Hall.
