

Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen's meeting Feb. 27, 2017

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis, Tim O'Brien and Jim Rousmaniere

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of February 21 were approved.

Selectmen O'Brien reported about a meeting that he had had with a representative of the city of Keene regarding private property holdings that abut city-owned watershed lands. The city is preparing for a land-use study of its Roxbury holdings.

The selectmen proof-read the Town Report that is due to be sent to the printers in the coming week.

The selectmen received an abatement request from Eversource; the request was forwarded to Avitar, the town's contracted property appraiser.

The selectmen denied a special permit request by Granite Gorge for a snowmobile hill climb that it wants to hold on March 18. The reason for the denial was that Granite Gorge had not responded to -- or otherwise acted on -- a letter from the selectmen that stated that such hill climbs are not among the allowed uses according to the town's zoning laws; the selectmen had directed Granite Gorge to take up the matter with the town planning board.

Selectman Davis prepared the manifest of bills to be paid; the manifest was signed by the selectmen.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
