

## Minutes from the Roxbury Selectmen's meeting Feb.8, 2016

In attendance: Selectmen Karen Cota, Gerry Davis and Jim Rousmaniere; citizen Chip Drogue.

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of Feb. 1 were read and approved.

The Selectmen reviewed the proposed budget in anticipation of at budget hearing at 7:30 p.m.

At 7:30 in the main hall the budget hearing was opened by Selectman Karen Cota. There was one member of the public in attendance, former Selectman Chip Drogue. No significant questions were raised. The hearing was closed at 8:15 p.m.

It was agreed that the Selectmen will respond to a request by the city of Keene for a demolition permit related to water-treatment-related structures in town to the effect that the Selectmen will not require a permit application but will ask the city of Keene to keep them informed of any correspondence or permitting involving the state Department of Environmental Services.

The Selectmen agreed that the Town Report will (a) be dedicated to volunteers who help out the town and (b) will carry a memorial mention (and possibly photographs) of residents who died in the last year.

Much time was spent on matters related to the preparation of the Town Report.

The meeting adjourned at 9:20 p.m.
