

Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen's meeting Jan. 23, 2017

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis, Tim O'Brien and Jim Rousmaniere;

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of January 17 were approved.

There was a brief discussion regarding budget preparations and the loading of relevant budget information on the state Department of Revenue Administration web portal.

At 7:15 p.m. the selectmen entered into an executive session that involved discussion of potential litigation concerning the status of a road in town. The executive session ended at 7:40 p.m.

The selectmen took up the fact that some activities at the Granite Gorge ski area, in particular hill-climbs, are not permitted under the Town's zoning regulations. A letter will be drafted and sent to Granite Gorge that directs Granite Gorge to approach the Planning Board to discuss the matter.

It was formally agreed that there will be two budget hearings, the first to be held at 6:30 p.m. on Monday, Feb. 13 and the second to be held at 6:30 p.m. on Monday Feb. 20)

Selectman Davis prepared the manifest of bills to be paid; the manifest was signed by the selectmen.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
