

## Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen meeting July 17, 2017

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis, Tim O'Brien and Jim Rousmaniere; Police Chief Rob O'Connor.

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of July 10 were approved.

The selectmen accepted Amy Bodwell's request for a leave of absence from the co-chairmanship of the Roxbury Planning Board.

Police Chief O'Connor reported that the watershed patrol services agreement worked out with the city of Keene is now in force.

Selectman Rousmaniere offered to discuss with representatives of the Southwest Region Planning Commission its findings so far from its survey of the roughly 75 culverts beneath public roads in town.

It was noted that David Stulstatz would be visiting town during the upcoming weekend and would be willing to discuss architectural aspects of the proposed salt shed project.

Selectman Davis prepared the manifest of bills to be paid; the manifest was signed by the selectmen.

The meeting adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
