

Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen meeting July 24, 2017

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis and Jim Rousmaniere; Police Chief Rob O'Connor, Road Agent Ken Buffum.

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of July 17 were approved.

The selectmen took note of the receipt of a notice from the state Department of Transportation regarding its intention to purchase for \$2,500 roughly one acre's worth of slope and draining easements from Granite Gorge in connection with its planned improvements to Route 9.

Selectmen Rousmaniere reported on a recategorization of a line item in the towns MS-535 filing for the year 2017. The step does not alter the financial or budget status of the town.

The town took receipt of an updated Hazard Mitigation plan for the town; the material is available for public inspection at the selectmen's office in Town Hall.

Road Agent Buffum reported that he had acquired for the town a Husqvarna brush cutter for use in clearing brush on the sides of town roads. A \$599.99 bill for the device, the purchase of which had previously been approved by the selectmen, was submitted for payment. Selectman Davis noted that the tool should be entered on the town's inventory of equipment.

There was discussion of a meeting the prior week end with David Stulstanz regarding planned improvements to the salt shed. It was agreed that Building Inspector Don Castagna would be provided a copy of the building plans to cost out the materials side of the project.

Selectman Davis prepared the manifest of bills to be paid; the manifest was signed by the selectmen.

The meeting adjourned at 9:10 p.m.
