

Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen meeting July 31, 2017

In attendance: Selectmen Tim O'Brien and Jim Rousmaniere.

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of July 24 were approved.

Selectman Rousmaniere reported that a revised MS-535 form had been completed and awaits the signatures of all three selectmen prior to submission to the New Hampshire Department of Revenue Administration.

It was noted that a special event permit application check for an event August 12 had been received from Granite Gorge, but the selectmen are unable to locate an actual application for a permit for such event. It was agreed that Granite Gorge will be contacted regarding that matter.

The selectmen discussed a communication from Charter Cable relative to a selectmen's request to meet to discuss extending cable service in town as part of that company's franchise relicensing in town. It was agreed that the selectmen will take up Charter on its offer to survey the town for housing density, which is a factor in its provision of service.
