As a Lions club member, you can:

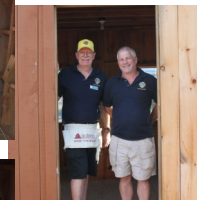
- ◆ Make a difference every day in your Community. Whether it is providing support locally or reaching out internationally, you will have an opportunity to serve.
