

Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen's meeting March 6, 2017

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis, Tim O'Brien and Jim Rousmaniere; Fred Baybutt of Granite Gorge

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of February 27 were approved.

The selectmen split up responsibilities for delivering the printed Town Report (with the Roxbury Report newsletter inserted) to homes in town. It was noted that no other town government delivers Town Reports to residents, and instead provides for residents to pick them up at Town Hall. The selectmen agreed that this will be the last year that they hand-deliver Town Reports to town residents. It was noted that the Town Report for 2016 is posted on the town web site.

The selectmen received a request by a Sentinel reporter for a copy of the town warrant and ballot for the upcoming March 14 town meeting. It was agreed that the reporter will be alerted to the digital posting of the Town Report on the town web site

Fred Baybutt of Granite Gorge, responding to a denial of an application for a special event the prior week, provided assurances that, as the selectmen had stipulated as a condition of any permit approval, he will approach the town planning board regarding changes to the listing of allowable events at the site. Following those assurances, the selectmen approved the permit application for a snowmobile hill climb at Granite Gorge in March 18.

The selectmen discussed a resident's complaint about potholes on the Davis Road and agreed to alert Road Agent Ken Buffum to the matter.

The selectmen reviewed an abatement request from New England Telephone and agreed to forward the request to Avitar, the town's property appraiser.

Selectman Davis prepared the manifest of bills to be paid; the manifest was signed by the selectmen.

The meeting adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
