

Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen meeting May 30, 2017

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis and Jim Rousmaniere; Fire Chief Tim Mason, Former selectman Chip Drogue.

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of May 15 were approved.

The meeting was generally uneventful.

Selectman Rousmaniere briefly reported on the first meeting of a watershed management study committee that was organized by the city of Keene to inventory its water-supply properties in Roxbury and Nelson and ultimately draft policies related to the land. Other participants include representatives from the city and the state of New Hampshire.

It was reported that two financial reports due the state identified as MS-232 and MS-636 had been signed by the selectmen and transmitted to the state Department of Revenue Administration.

Selectman Davis prepared the manifest of bills to be paid; the manifest was signed by the selectmen.
