

## Minutes from the Roxbury Selectmen's meeting May 2, 2016

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis and Jim Rousmaniere; Police Chief Rob O'Connor; Road Agent Ken Buffum

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. The meeting of April 25 was generally uneventful, so no minutes were taken.

The Selectmen discussed the community clean-up of town cemeteries that occurred on April 30. A report about the project, including the names of the many volunteers who took part, will be prepared and published in forthcoming minutes.

It was noted that Danielle Droque has agreed to stand in as interim chairman of the new conservation commission. It was agreed that she will be approached about the timing of the launch of the commission.

It was noted that Avitar, the appraisal firm employed by the town, has announced that it will no longer appraise the value of utility poles, conduits and rights-of-way. The selectmen took the matter under advisement, given the continuing legal and legislative activities associated with the poles, etc.

The selectmen agreed to the language of a letter to parties who previously filled intent-to-cut papers but who have not since filed reports on the results of their planned timber cuts on which taxes are to assessed. The letter, which was drafted by Selectman Tim O'Brien, asks for updated information

The manifest of bills to be paid was completed and signed.

The meeting adjourned at 9:10 p.m.
