

## Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen's meeting Nov. 7, 2016

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis and Jim Rousmaniere; Police Chief Rob O'Connor; former selectman Chip Drogue.

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. Minutes from the meeting of Oct. 24 were approved.

The Selectmen received a final and original copy of a police patrol agreement with Keene regarding the Roaring Brook watershed that has been under discussion during the last several months. A copy of the agreement was presented to Chief O'Connor

There was a brief discussion regarding the continuing matter of the Society for the Protection of NH Forests' concerns about a road on the Taves reservation. It was reported that an inspection tour of the particular area had been conducted. It was agreed that the matter will be taken up by the selectmen at their next meeting following the general election.

It was reported that the volunteer-led Halloween party at Town Hall on Oct, 29 was a success.

There was extended discussion regarding the preliminary tax rate that had been determined by the Department of Revenue Administration. The selectmen voted to approve a revised tax rate pending a review by the DRA.

The selectmen took note of the fact that the polls are ready for the next day's general election.

Selectman Davis prepared the manifest of bills to be paid; the manifest was signed by the selectmen.

The meeting adjourned at 9:15 p.m.
