

Minutes of the Roxbury Selectmen meeting Sept. 11, 2017

In attendance: Selectmen Gerry Davis, Tim O'Brien and Jim Rousmaniere; Emergency Management Director Chip Drogue

The meeting opened at 7 p.m. The minutes for the Sept. 5 meeting were read and approved.

Chip Drogue reported that due to economies in the purchase of equipment under an emergency management grant, there remained approximately \$660 to be applied to other purposes. He reported that he awaits approval by state officials for the expenditure of such funds on an air conditioning unit for town hall, among other objects.

Nicholas Mosher, the town's representative on the Monadnock School Board, reported that the school board will soon begin to consider the possibility altering the school funding formula within the district. He asserted that, were a petition to change the formula within the district to be considered at the deliberative session early in 2018, townspeople from Roxbury best participate in that session.

He added that the Monadnock School Board will next meet in Town Hall on November 21, with the meeting beginning at 7 p.m.

The selectmen approved and signed an updated Hazard Mitigation Plan for the town.

The selectmen received a communication regarding past documentation related to the construction of a cell tower in town. It was agreed that the cell tower consultant seeking the information will be invited to visit town hall to go through the documents, which are extensive.

The selectmen agreed that a portion of the Davis Road that had previously been the subject of maintenance and repair discussion should be repaired with a patch of the existing holes and then pavement. Selectman O'Brien will discuss the matter with Road Agent Buffum.

The selectmen discussed a drainage issue regarding Hardy Hill Road. A letter to a property owner near the problem area will be contacted.

It was agreed that Treasurer David Jewett will be invited to attend next week's selectmen's meeting to discuss budget updates for the year.

Selectman Davis prepared the manifest of bills to be paid; the manifest was signed by the selectmen. The meeting adjourned at 8:55 p.m.
